

National Talent Coach (Region)

Objective: To work with the Talent Lead and British Wrestling to deliver a high-quality National Talent and Regional Squad experience for young wrestlers in the British Wrestling talent pathway

Reports to: Talent Lead

Payment: £70 per day payment plus travel expenses if travelling over 50 miles

Responsibilities:

- Work with the Talent Lead and the BWA to schedule of regular National Talent Squad training sessions (expected x8 per year)
- Deliver regular National Talent Squad training sessions with other National Talent Coaches
- Deliver regular Regional Squad training sessions with support from Assistant Regional Coaches (expected x8 per year)
- Implement a high-quality training, in line with the Talent Pathway, that develops and maximises the potential of athletes on the Regional and National Squads
- Work with the Talent Lead, Regional and Club coaches to select athletes onto the National Squad and motivate them to attend training sessions and camps
- Work with the Talent Lead and Regional Coaches to plan, prepare and supervise weekly, monthly and yearly practice and competition schedules and to produce individual athlete profiles to ensure athletes' development
- Deliver a wrestling training environment that allows athletes to maximise their potential in a safe manner
- Act as lead coach on National Talent Squad camps and competitions as required

Requirements:

- UKCC Level 2 Wrestling Coach with current DBS check, safeguarding training and first aid certificate
- Experience of coaching wrestling at a high level, having expert knowledge and credibility
- Knowledge and experience of wrestling in the UK
- Excellent interpersonal skills with ability to communicate effectively at all levels
- Excellent organisational and administrative skills
- Ability to prioritise and attention to detail
- Self-motivated and able to work independently
- Experience of supervising and working with a team
- Ability to problem solve for yourself and others
- Ability to remain calm in high pressure situations
- Complying with all aspects of British Wrestling's Safeguarding Policy
- Current Driving Licence
- Be committed to supporting the prevention of doping behaviour and ensuring compliance with WADA cod
