

## Regional Squad Manager

Objective: To work with the National Coach (Region) and British Wrestling to deliver a high-quality Regional Squad experience for young wrestlers in the British Wrestling talent pathway

Reports to: Talent Lead

Payment: £50 per day payment plus travel expenses if travelling over 50 miles

### Responsibilities:

- Work with the National Coach (Region) and the BWA to schedule of regular training sessions (expected x8 per year)
- Monitor attendance at Regional Squad training sessions
- Collect Athlete Contributions for training sessions/camps and administer payment to BWA
- Maintain a list of athletes on the Regional Squad
- Act as main point of contact for the Regional Squad for athletes and parents/guardians
- Act as safeguarding officer for Regional Squad training sessions
- Work with other Regional Squad Managers to act as safeguarding officer on National Talent Squad training sessions, camps and competitions

### Requirements:

- Safeguarding trained with a current DBS check
- Knowledge and experience of wrestling in the UK
- Excellent interpersonal skills with ability to communicate effectively at all levels
- Excellent organisational and administrative skills
- Ability to prioritise and attention to detail
- Self-motivated and able to work independently
- Experience of supervising and working with a team
- Ability to problem solve for yourself and others
- Ability to remain calm in high pressure situations
- Complying with all aspects of British Wrestling's Safeguarding Policy
- Current Driving Licence
- Be committed to supporting the prevention of doping behaviour and ensuring compliance with WADA code
